Palace of the Shirvanshahs

This famous palace, which dates back to the 1400s, is comprised of five distinct sections. Its complex is an ideal place for travelers who want to learn more about the area's culture, architecture and traditions to visit. Construction on the palace's main building began in 1411. Visitors can enter through its portal and make their way to the Divankhana—a stone pavilion inside the courtyard.



Baku Ferris Wheel

Boasting a prime location on a boulevard overlooking the Caspian Sea, the Baku Ferris Wheel (Baku Eye) offers panoramic views of the city and its coastal surroundings. The wheel was originally built for the Eurovision Song Contest, which Azerbaijan hosted in 2012, and has since become one of the city's most visible attractions.



Martyrs' Lane

In the early days of 1990 during the dissolution of the Soviet Union, Baku was the site of a violent crackdown on the Azerbaijani independence movement. Martyrs' Lane is a memorial to some 15,000 Azerbaijani heroes, including those who lost their lives during the Black January massacre. Rising from the center of the memorial is the Eternal Flame.



Miniature Book Museum

The Baku Museum of Miniature Books is the only museum of miniature books in the world, settled in the old part of Baku, called Inner City.[1] The museum started its operation on April 2, 2002. In 2015 the Museum of Miniature Books was presented the Certificate of the Guinness Book of Records as the largest private museum of miniature books.



Highland Park

Highland Park is one of the most famous and interesting sights of Baku. The green zone is located above Baku Bay. The park in its original form, which has been preserved today, with spacious stairs, shady alleys and cosy terraces, was created by the famous architect Lev Ilyin. During the construction of the Park, Baku limestone was used as the main material.



Baku Old City (Icherisheher)

In December of 2000, this popular destination became the first ever UNESCO World Heritage-listed site in Azerbaijan. Home to the Palace of the Maiden Tower and the Palace of the Shirvanshahs, the famous Old City is an epicenter of history, culture and tradition that attracts travelers from across the globe. Age is evident in the surrounding architecture—not just in design, but because many of the buildings are in disrepair—and the picturesque streets of Old City are ideal for exploring. Whether it's the back alleyways, souvenir shops, museums or the palace interior.



Azerbaijan National Carpet Museum

The popular Azerbaijan Carpet Museum, located in the heart of Azerbaijan, is hometown one of the most extensive rug and carpet collections in the world. Travelers can wander the well-corrated halls lined with colorful tapestries that showcase various weaving techniques and materials collected throughout the nation's history. Since 2014 this incredible destination has been operating out of its newly renovated home, where some 10,000 items - including more than just carpets - are proudly displayed. But it's the collection from the Shusha Museum of History, which includes some 600 carpets from a city.



Maiden Tower

The Maiden Tower, a UNESCO World Heritage-listed site, is located inside the walled-city of Baku and known by locals as Giz Galasi. Built in the 12th century, this iconic structure, which rises up into the otherwise empty skyline, is one of the city's most distinctive buildings. Travelers who head to the Maiden Tower can visit the museum that's housed inside and learn about the walled city's history, culture and revolution. Ambitious adventurers can climb the stairs to the top of the tower where they'll be met with incredible views of the Caspian Sea and the surrounding city.



Flame Towers

Relatively new to the skyline—they were only completed in 2012 the three glass skyscrapers that comprise the Flame Towers have already become iconic. The three towers sit atop a hill overlooking the old city center and Baku Bay and were inspired by the ancient practice of fire worship in Azerbaijan. By day, the blue-tinted reflective towers are impressive, but they're truly spectacular after dark, when their surfaces become a giant display for more than 10,000 LED lights that paint the towers with colors of fire, water or the national flag.

It's estimated that 300 of the planet's estimated 700 mud volcanoes are located in Gobustan, Azerbaijan, and the Caspian Sea. Mud volcanoes of Gobustan are a popular attraction for both scientists and tourists, the latter often bathing in mud, which is thought to have medicinal qualities.



Ateshgah: "Fire Temple of Baku"

Ateshgah, or the Fire Temple of Baku, is an ancient religious site in Azerbaijan built around a natural gas vent that ignites flames. It's a UNESCO World Heritage site with beautiful architecture and a rich history as a Hindu, Sikh, and Zoroastrian temple.



Yanardagh "Burning Mountain"

Guests will be taken to Yanardagh, located in Digah village. This is a spot of naturally burning gas, which comes out of ground. The fire here started many centuries ago and still burning. Although the size of the fire decreased over large exploration of gas resources in Absheron, the place is still very interesting and authentic.



Gobustan National Park

Gobustan National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site in Azerbaijan, boasts ancient rock carvings depicting prehistoric life and rituals. The park also features unique mud volcanoes, creating a captivating blend of historical and natural wonders.



Bibiheybat Mosque

Juma Mosque Shamakhi

Shamakhi's greatest landmark is Juma Mosque, one of Azerbaijan's largest and most lavish places of worship. While the current structure was reconstructed in 2013, the earliest version was built way back in 743AD, making this the second oldest mosque in the Caucasus and the oldest in Azerbaijan. Since then it has been destroyed and rebuilt several times, most notably during the devastating earthquake that reduced Shamakhi to rubble in 1859 and later by inter-ethnic clashes in 1918. Besides discovering its historical and religious significance, you can enjoy simply basking in the site's elegance and tranquility.

Mud Volcanos

Mud volcanoes are formed by the eruption of natural gases and mud from the earth's surface. These geological formations are quite different from the conventional volcanoes that are formed by the eruption of lava and volcanic rocks. There are more than 400 mud volcanoes in Azerbaijan, and the majority of them are located in and around the Absheron Peninsula, which is where Baku is situated. The largest mud volcano in the world, the Boyuk Khanizadagh, is also located in Azerbaijan, about 15 km from Baku.

Prior to starting the practice, the visitors are trained by the instructors and the safety rules are explained, following that they are fully ready to show off their abilities. During the training and shooting period, each visitor is accompanied by a private guide. Shooting competitions at distances of 10, 25, 50 and 300 metres can be held in the center, and the number of competitors is determined based on these distances.



Shahdag Rollercoaster

Located at 1430 metres above sea level, the coaster features a 1670m track with 9 thrilling turns, allowing adrenaline seekers the unique opportunity to experience the stunning mountain scenery, snow-covered in winter and perfectly green in summer, while zooming down at 42km/h. The 50 sleds installed on the attraction allow 300-350 people to use it per hour.
